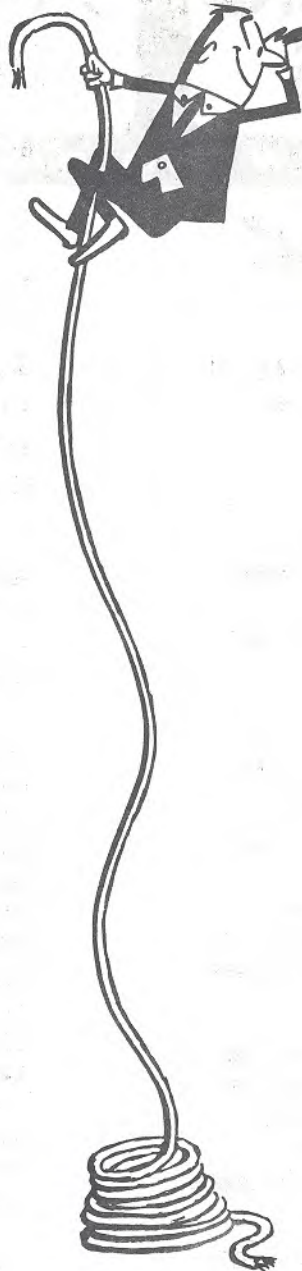

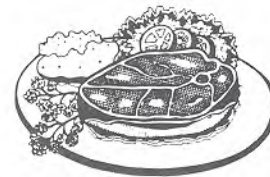

All Slides must have been exposed, and script written and narrated by the maker(s). The audio may be presented in any manner desired and competitors may receive assistance to put commentary and music on tape. Should the number of entries exceed the time allotted to this competition, an outside judge will pre-screen and reduce the number of entries.

The entries in Honor Print and Slide competitions must have been previously exhibited in regular monthly competitions during the current year.
