**Blair Seitz** - professional photographer, with current publications: Historical Places (Seitz & Seitz), and a 1990 calendar, Historical Places. Blair is also a vice-president of a professional association of magazine photographers that has annual exhibits and education program meetings at HACC.

**Mark Rosnick** - Manager, Letts Camera Store, and photographic educator. As a former photographer for the daily Sentinel newspaper, Mark will appeal to all competitors in both print categories.

Another way to expand your competition know-how is to join the Photographic Society of America (PSA). The meetings and conventions, competition experience, seminars, and monthly magazine offer a wealth of information to everyone. In a recent article, "Judging Revisited", various club competitors advise PSA members to be on the "lookout" for interesting photographic "happenings". The "happenings" may be a sunset behind the State Capitol dome, stormy weather near a lighthouse, sunrise at a New England farm, and interesting lighting effects at T.M.I. Several interesting and acceptable shots may be exposed by varying the angles, aperture and shutter speed, foreground, sky effects, and lighting of the scene area. Even returning on different days or seasons of the year can make a "happening".

Judges can make or break a particular picture. Don't let that deter you! All of the above factors are worthwhile in PSA competitions. PSA offers information and education. Talk with Gigi Luto. Good luck. Have fun and excitement in photography in 1990.

Each club member is allowed up to a total of six entries: two slides, two color prints, and two black & white prints. Entries are \$1.00 each, for a total up to \$6.00. The more you enter, the more it benefits the club. Awards will be 1st, 2nd, 3rd, & 2 HM & ties will be broken. All entries must have the maker's name, title, division (slides, b/w or color prints) and "HCC" affixed. Prints may be "mounted or matted"; **NO FRAMES**. Maximum mount or mat size is 16" X 20". Maximum print size is 11" X 14" or 154 sq. inches. Andy Hoff would like to receive your entries no later than Dec. 19th, the night of the print competition.
