### Bylaws proposal to be voted on March 13, 1990. Plan on attending the meeting.

A proposed addition to the Bylaws has been made and will be voted on at the Mar. 13th meeting BEFORE the competition. Vote will be by secret ballot. You will be asked to either keep Article I, Section 4 as it is or to include the proposed addition. Below is the appropriate section with the proposed addition underlined.

Section 4. Print and color slide competitors may exhibit a maximum of two (2) prints or three (3) slides in each regular monthly competition, and two (2) prints or three (3) slides in special competitions. Photographic image(s) taken of similar or of the same subject(s) at different time periods, e.g. seasons, time of day, changing lighting conditions, & different angles will be eligible. Prints and color slides previously accepted in competition, or so similar as to be almost identical, regardless of title, are ineligible.
