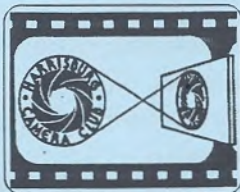

Dear Members,



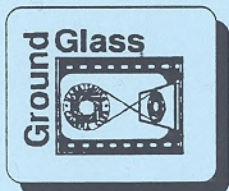
